3rd Quarter Highlights

Application activity picked up in the third quarter after a slower second quarter. The residential sector was strong, particularly smaller-scale construction projects with variance applications. Residential lot creation was also strong, with 88 subdivision lots, including 14 townhomes, in the Summerside and Walker West Estates subdivisions in Port Elgin and Walkerton respectively. The Agricultural sector continued to be resilient, with five farm consolidations. Notable institutional, commercial and industrial applications include zoning amendments to address burdensome provisions in Saugeen Shores and permitting Licensed Cannabis Operations in Walkerton.

Map Summary

There were new applications in most urban and rural parts of the County.

Staff approved a Local Official Plan Amendment to permit a change of use from a Church to a mixed commercial/residential use in Walkerton, and an amendment to adjust the Open Space boundary to provide for parking for an apartment building in a subdivision in Mildmay.
