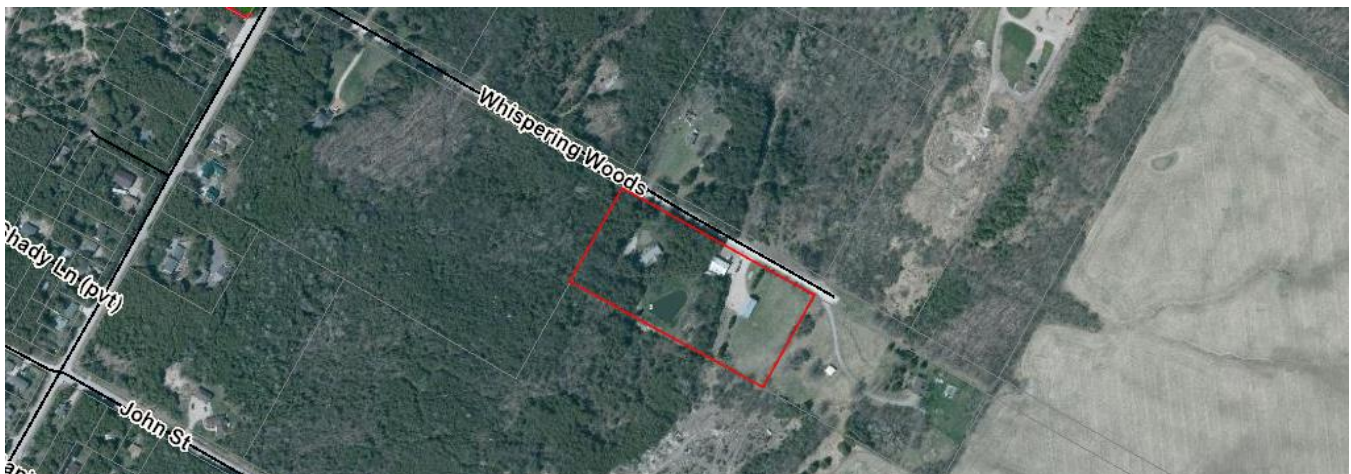

County Official Plan Amendment #C-2021-013

November 18, 2021 at 9:45 am

A change is proposed in your neighbourhood: The purpose of the proposed consent application is to create a new residential lot approximately 4,115 square metres (1.01 acres) from an existing residential property. The retained lot is proposed to be approximately 1.97 ha (4.9 acres). Additional Planning Act applications are required to facilitate the consent. The proposed Bruce County Official Plan Amendment is requesting relief of the requirement for full municipal services. The Local Official Plan Amendment is proposed to address Kincardine's infilling policies. The proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment seeks to rezone the lands from the Planned Development 'PD' to the Residential One 'R1' zone.

The related applications are: Consent Application B-2021-053; Zoning Bylaw Amendment Application Z-2021-047; and Local Official Plan Amendment Application L-2021-011.

If you'd like to be notified of the decision of the approval authority on the proposed application(s), you must make a written request to the Bruce County Planning Department.

Know your rights

Section 17(36) of the [Planning Act](#) outlines rights of appeal for Official Plan Amendment applications.

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the County of Bruce to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the County before the proposed official plan (or official plan amendment) is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the County before the proposed official plan (or official plan amendment) is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
