With regard to the proposed expansion of Lands End Park, we would like to present the following areas of concern for your careful consideration:

<!--[if !supportLists]-->• <!--[endif]-->Lack of safety measures at Lands End Park (for current guests):

<!--[if !supportLists]-->○ <!--[endif]-->No lifeguard on beach and no cordoned swimming area (motorized boats approach and pull up on the beach, young swimmers with no PFDs swimming in deep areas of the bay, lack of water safety of guests i.e., taking a baby on a paddleboard with no apparent PFD)

<!--[if !supportLists]-->○ <!--[endif]-->No lifeguard on dock (swimmers use boat launch and dock while boats are launched or docking)

<!--[if !supportLists]-->○ <!--[endif]-->Lack of acknowledgement of “no wake” in this part of the Bay by those operating motorized watercraft

<!--[if !supportLists]-->• <!--[endif]-->Increase in alcohol consumption on beach and on party rafts (that has escalated to profanity in the past)
