Staff Recommendation:

The Request from the Family and Residents Councils at Brucelea Haven, regarding Saugeen Mobility Regional Transit report is for information.

Background:

The attached letter was sent by the Family Council and Residents Councils at Brucelea Haven identifying their concerns over the reduction in service from Saugeen Mobility and Regional Transit (SMART) and its impact on the residents and visitors of Brucelea Haven.

Transportation & Environmental Staff (TES) will respond via email, thanking them for their letter and providing the following update:

- SMART made a delegation to the Transportation and Environmental Services
 Committee requesting that Bruce County look at funding this service instead of the
 current model. The Committee directed staff to contact SMART and further the
 discussion.
- The Director of SMART is no longer with the organization and therefore TES staff have not yet reached out to SMART. The intention is to do so and look for a Business Plan from SMART that could be presented to Council as part of the 2023 budget discussions.
- 3. Through a request for additional funding of Council, Grey Transit Route expanded the Walkerton stops to include a stop in front of Brucelea Haven and Walkerton Hospital.
