a. AutoPulse Automated CPR Machine

That the request to purchase five (5) Autopulse Automated CPR Machines, be approved and paid for using COVID funding if authorized and any unfunded amount be paid by utilizing Paramedic Services Reserves at a total cost of approximately \$88,476.35 +HST; and,

That the request to purchase an additional six (6) Autopulse Automated CPR Machines at a cost of approximately \$98,290.42 +HST, be approved and paid from the Paramedic Services Reserves; and,

That the Autopulse automated CPR machines be single sourced to Zoll Medical Canada due to the current defibrillator's being Zoll. The Zoll AutoPulse A-CPR board works wirelessly with our existing monitors and the Zoll AutoPulse also utilizes what is called "ShockSync" Technology. These technologies work together to wirelessly calculate when the heart is best able to respond to paramedic treatments such as defibrillation of the heart at the least measured impedance, "Optimal Time".
