Please find 3 separate e-mails concerning water runoff from the proposed development onto our property this year. I would have sent them all in one e-mail but being a senior citizen with basic computer skills I have to do it this way.

My name is Bill Mckeag. I live at 39 Inverlyn Cres. S. Kincardine. This is Lot 135 on your map. My wife Barbara & I have lived here for 47 yrs. We are situated directly west of the proposed development. Until app. 8-10 yrs. ago when they put in new roads in Huron Ridge & new Condo's on Golf links Rd. we didn't have problems with flooding from the bush/vacant lots to the east of us. Now we have severe flooding 1-2 times per yr. usually in the spring coming from the lots to the east of us.

I have several video's from past yrs. But they are too long to send. I have gone to the expense of installing drains in my window wells. I've had the swale between our house & # 41 Inverlyn Cres. S. re- engineered. This is where the water is flowing from the vacant lots to the road.

My concern is obviously water runoff.
