Public Meeting Notice

You're invited to a Public Meeting to consider Bruce County Official Plan Amendment C-2024-002 July 4, 2024 at 9:30 am

A change is proposed in your neighbourhood: The purpose of the application is to establish a home industry use, specifically an automobile repair and service shop on the lands, in addition to the commercial trailer park and the accessory residential dwelling. The new use would occupy the existing administrative office building and would employ a maximum of two employees. The proposed new home industry use requires amendments to the County Official Plan, the Town of South Bruce Peninsula Official Plan and the Town's Zoning By-law. The related Local Official Plan Amendment file is L-2024-004 and the related Zoning By-Law Amendment file is Z-2024-017.

If you'd like to be notified of the decision of the approval authority on the proposed application, you must make a written request to the Bruce County Planning Department.

Know your rights

Section 17(36) of the <u>Planning Act</u> outlines rights of appeal for Official Plan Amendment applications.

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the County of Bruce to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Bruce County Planning Department before the proposed official plan (or official plan amendment) is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Bruce County Planning Department before the proposed official plan (or official plan amendment) is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
