Report Purpose:

Report Summary:

This report provides an information update on the results of the Employment Service System Manager (SSM) to the end of Quarter 2 (September 30, 2024). It also outlines continuous improvement efforts planned.

Background/Analysis:

The Counties of Bruce (lead), Grey, Huron, and the City of Stratford are the Employment Service System Manager (SSM), funded entirely by the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development (MLITSD), for the Stratford - Bruce Peninsula Economic Region.

The role of the SSM is to build and implement a locally responsive employment services system that effectively meets the needs of a diverse range of job seekers and employers in the catchment area. Integrated Employment Services Delivery (IESD), the SSM newly designed system went live on April 1, 2023.

The attached report provides a semi-annual update to Council on the performance of the SSM, and updates on future work to be completed.

MLITSD extended the SSMs agreement for two years, now ending March 31, 2027.
