

Infection Prevention and Control: Why It's Important to Get Vaccinated Annually for the Flu

Each year, flu strains change, and by receiving the updated vaccine, you are providing the best defense against circulating viruses. The flu can be particularly severe for older adults and those with weakened immune systems, which is why annual vaccination is vital in long-term care settings like ours.

By receiving the vaccine, we not only protect ourselves but also those around us, including residents who are more vulnerable to serious complications from the flu. We are entering respiratory outbreak season and influenza remains a major cause of illness and hospitalizations during the fall and winter months.
