Did you know?

- Our maintenance team has completed 4340 maintenance requests so far this year, plus many other tasks.

- Housekeeping is consistently deep cleaning rooms, taking out garbage and ensuring high touch areas are clean, along with many other tasks, to ensure a healthy and safe resident experience.
