Re: Impact of Bookmobile on Circulation

#### Purpose:

This report is for information.

#### **Report Summary:**

This report explores whether circulation from the Bookmobile has impacted circulation in library branches.

#### **Background:**

The Bookmobile began operating in October 2023, with 2024 marking its first full year of service. Bookmobile stops were selected in order to bring library services to underserved areas, as well as to those who may have difficulties getting to a Branch. Stops include parks, municipal buildings, County housing complexes, seniors' residences, long term care homes, schools, and daycares. Some stops are seasonal. For example, the Point Clark Lighthouse is visited during the spring and summer months while schools are visited during the fall and winter.

As illustrated on the map below, there are ten Branches with Bookmobile stops in the same community.

In 2024, the average Bookmobile stop circulation was .94% of the circulation of the nearest Branch.

The community with the highest average circulation (4.42%) at Bookmobile stops compared to the Branch was Paisley. The Paisley Branch saw an increase of 7.54% in circulation from 2023 to 2024, demonstrating no negative impact as a result of the two Bookmobile stops in the community. Paisley did experience some significant service changes in this time period, including the reconstruction of the Paisley Bridge, which impacted access to the branch, as well as its relocation to the Community Centre in July 2024.

An analysis of 2024 circulation does not show a correlation between Bookmobile stops in communities where there are Library Branches, and a decrease in circulation at those Branches. Two of the Branches with the greatest decrease in circulation in 2024 - Ripley (20%) and Mildmay (14.62%) do not have a Bookmobile stop in their community, providing evidence that the Bookmobile is not directly responsible for decreased circulation in some locations.

Staff will continue to track Bookmobile circulation and monitor its impact on Library Branch circulation.
