- **Skill development:** Anchored by the flexible, innovation-driven NII Advance Technology Campus, available to rent for educational programming, big and small events and dedicated workspaces, key skill development initiatives in 2024 included collaborative welding training programs, the unique NII Energy Co-op, and STEM events for students around the region.
- **Industry advancement:** Securing tomorrow through process improvement, 2024 saw the launch of *Kaizen for Nuclear*, a program in partnership with Bruce Power, NII's Founding Members, and partner vendors from the nuclear supply chain that reimagines processes, boosts efficiency and empowers workers on every level.

"The successes in this Annual Report are the result of the incredible dedication of our team, the support of our Founding Members and the collaborative spirit of our partners and communities," said Jessica Linthorne, NII President and CEO. "Together, we are proving that innovation is not the domain of a few—it is the work of all of us."
