In November, Ontario announced publicly funded access to the first Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) vaccine Arexvy (Ah-REX-vee), available to residents 60 years and older living in long-term care homes. We are currently working towards a vaccination clinic date, and obtaining consents for eligible residents at Brucelea and Gateway Haven. We continue to offer the Influenza and COVID vaccinations to all staff and residents who are eligible and interested.
