Report Purpose:

That the Director of Long-Term Care and Senior Services be authorized to sign and submit a Declaration of Compliance for Brucelea Haven and Gateway Haven to Ontario Health for the reporting period of January 1, 2023 - December 31, 2023.

Report Summary:

The Long-Term Care Service Accountability Agreement (L-SAA) is a legal document between the Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) and Bruce County. A requirement of the L-SAA is that an annual Declaration of Compliance is signed and submitted to the LHIN.

Background:

The Declaration confirms that the provisions of the L-SAA for the period ending March 31, 2024, have been met during the reporting period and requires an annual authorization for signing rather than a blanket delegation by-law. The reporting period for this declaration is January 1, 2023 - December 31, 2023.

Confirmation has been received from the Director of Long-Term Care and Senior Services, the current Administrators at Brucelea Haven and Gateway Haven and County Corporate Services staff that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, all obligations under the L-SAA have been fulfilled during the reporting period.

A finalized draft of the Declaration of Compliance for both homes is attached to this report.
